Ordered that the following persons take the list of taxable property in the following districts to wit: Nicholas Maget in the same as last year with the addition of that part of Nansmond lying to the Southward of Nottoway which has been lately added to this county, George Gurley in the same as last year, William Blunt in the same as last year, Benjamin Blunt in Capt. Kirby's district, Thomas Turner in the same as last year, Thomas Ridley in Capt. Myrick's district, Etcheldred Taylor in the same as last year, John Simmons in Capt. Simmons company, Elias Herring in Capt. Wells's company, Missah Rollman in the same district as last year, David Barron in Capt. Herring's company and that part of Nansmond on the north of Nottoway lately added to Southampton and Josiah Vick in his own & Capt. Lewis districts.

An indenture, of bargain and sale between James Wilson and Martha his wife of the one part and Pharaoh Corbitt of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said James Wilson and Martha his wife she being first privately examined as the law directs and ordered to be recorded.

Pursuant to an act of Assembly intitled. An act to provide for the poor it is ordered that the county be divided into four districts to be divided by Nottoway river as it runs through this county and by Crossford's road from the Carolina line to Southampton court house and from thence to black water bridge near Elias Herring's by the road leading from the courthouse to the fork below Joseph Vick and down the right hand fork as that leads to the road that crosses the lower Scotch bridge and from thence to the said Scotch bridge and down the said swamp to black water, and that the Sheriff after due publication cause an election to be held in each of the above districts for the purpose of selecting three fit persons to be overseers of the poor, and that Nicholas Maget Gentl be appointed to superintend the election of the said overseers on the lower district on the south side of Nottoway, Benjamin Blunt in the upper district on that side of the river, Elias Herring in the lower district on the North side of Nottoway, and Samuel Wells in the upper district on the North side of the said river, and it is further ordered that the elections be held in each
