A relinquishment of dower from Elizabeth Moore widow and relict of James Moore decd. to Burnell Williamson and the receipt thereon endorsed were proved by the oaths of Benjamin White, James Vick and Ann Ingram the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

Ordered that the overseers of the poor in the upper district of Rottoway parish bind out Matthew and Miles Bradley orphans of John Bradley decd. to James Bell according to law
