by him in this behalf expended, to be levied of the goods and chattels which were of Giles Whitney

he hath in his hands to be administered, if not then the costs to be made of the proper goods and
chattels of the said defendant.

The petition of Dolphin Drew and Sarah his wife against William Kidley for Two pounds eleven
shillings and ten pence is ordered to be dismissed.

Upon the petition of Robert Steele a citizen of Thomas Turner against Barnwell Balf for one pound
thirteen shillings and two pence due by note and costs. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney
108th Oct^o and the defendant having been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and
not appearing on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover against
the defendant one pound thirteen shillings and two pence with interest thereon from
Novr. 25th 1774 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended. Mem^r. The plaintiff
acknowledges satisfaction of this judgment on the back of the bond January 7th 1784 for twenty one
shillings and eight pence.

Upon the petition of Christopher Freeman against James Garrity for one pound twelve shillings
due by note. This day came the plaintiff by John Nevison his attorney and the defendant having
been duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing on the motion
of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover against the defendant one pound
twelve shillings and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

Upon the petition of William Urquhart and Hartscell Cocke Executors of Thomas Clements Jr
deed. against Samuel Blake for Four pounds thirteen shillings and five pence due by account
and costs. This day came the plaintiffs by Richard Held their attorney and the defendant was
87th Oct^o not appearing being duly summoned and served with a copy of the petition and account and not ap-
pearing on the motion of the plaintiffs who proved their account to be just it is considered
by the court that they recover against the defendant Four pounds thirteen shillings and
five pence and their costs by them in this behalf expended.

Upon the petition of John Dale Esq^r & of Thomas Dale Jr. against John Applewhite Esq^r & of Henry
Applewhite deed. for Two pounds six shillings and six pence half penny due by account and costs.
This day came the plaintiff by Littleberry Mason his attorney and the defendant having been duly sum-
moned and served with a copy of the petition and account and not appearing on the motion of the
plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover against the defendant Two pounds six shillings
and six pence half penny and his costs by him in this behalf expended, to be levied of the ~~goods~~ goods
and chattels which were of Henry Applewhite deed. at the time of his death in the hands of the de-
fendant executor of the last will and testament of the said Henry, if so much thereof he hath in
his hands to be administered, if not then the costs to be made of the proper goods & chattels of the said
defendant.
