An indenture of bargain and sale between Peter Barr of the one part and William Bryant of the other part was proved by the oaths of William Bryant, Thomas Everett and Edmund Everett three of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

A mortgage from Benjamin Waller to Arthur Waller and the endorsement thereon were proved by the oaths of Daniel Fisher, John Wright and Charles Briggs the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between William Arguehart and Mary his wife of the one part and Lewis Stiner of the other part and the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by the said Mary she being first privily examined as the law directs and having been before acknowledged by William Arguehart are ordered to be recorded.
