James Bryant is appointed surveyor of the highway as far as Barnes' old stone and it is ordered that he with the male labouring tithables belonging to Jonathan Wilson and Edmund Barrett jun^r in addition to those now belonging to the said highway keep the same in repair according to law.

Ordered that John Calum, Theoton Everitt, Eazum Everitt and Jacob Barrett or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county, view the ground along which a road from the old county line to the country line is proposed to be conducted, and report truly and impartially the conveniences and inconveniences which will result as well to individuals as to the public.

And on the motion of the said executrix who made oath according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Elizabeth Mundell with John Glaud, John Mundell and Daniel Porter her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond on the penalty of Three thousand pounds for her due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will.
