Sumner the amount of one pound twelve shillings & six pence this cost by him in this behalf expended

On the motion of Wm Gualthrey a writup for Bailey at the suit of Peter it is ordered that the S. Bailey pay him three hundred & twenty five pounds of Tobacco for 13 days attendance on his Court according to Law

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 9^o Clock
