Ford James Catthraupe John Cobb James Bell Henry Westbrooke Howell Briggs Edward & James Summerell who being elected tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oath do say that the *def* is guilty of the trover and conversion in the declaration mentioned in manner and form as the plaintiffs against him hath complained and they do say the plaintiffs damages by occasion thereof to twelve pound twelve shillings and six pence Therefore it is considered by the court that the plaintiff recover his damages aforesaid in form aforesaid and against the said *def* his costs by him about his suit in this behalf expended to be levied of the goods and chattels of the said Edmund Day at the time of his death in the hands of the defendant to be administered if so much he hath if not then the costs to be levied of the troper goods and chattels of the *def* to be in money
