

Upon the petition of William Barrett against Jordan Brewster and Joshua Whitney &c
Sc of Giles Whitney. This day came as well the plaintiff by his attorney as the deft
in their proper persons who confessed that their debtor was indebted to the plaintiff Brown
for four barrel of corn. Therefor it is considered by the court that the plaintiffs recover
against the said deft his costs by him in this behalf expended to be levied of this
goods and chattels of which were of the s^t Giles Whitney at the time of his death in the
hands of of Jordan Brewster and Joshua Whitney to be administered if so much
thereof he hath if not the costs to be made of the proper goods and chattels of the
said defendants.

Upon the petition of Charles Edmunds a signee of W^m Edwards against Buff Williams
and William Crichton for five hundred pounds of Tobacco & interest due by note. This
day came the plaintiff by his attorney & the deft having been duly summoned and
Served with a copy of the petition and not appearing. Therefor on the motion of the plaintiff
it is considered by the court that he recover against the said deft the aforesaid
five hundred pounds of Virginia inspected crop Tobacco with interest thereon
after the rate of 5^{ft} per annum from the fifth day of December 1782 till paid
Memorandum February 1784. On the bond 160^{ft} Tobacco
Sept 5th 0^{ft} for 40 Job.^o

Upon the petition of Charles Edmunds a signee of W^m Edwards against Isaac Johnson
and Jacob Johnson for 413 and interest due by note. This day came the plaintiff
by his attorney and the defendant Isaac Johnson having been duly summoned
and served with a copy of the petition and not appearing. Therefor it is considered
by the court that he recover against the said deft Isaac Johnson the aforesaid
four pounds three shillings with interest thereon from the 22nd day of August 1782
till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended.

On the motion of Joseph Roper a witness for Howell Edmunds at the suit of
Elizabeth Moore it is ordered that the said Howell pay him four hundred and fifty
two pounds of Tobacco for eight days attendance in this court and riding 34 miles 6 times
and returning according to law.

Ordered that John Thomas Blaw^{et} & R Blaw pay to Joseph Roper 25^{ft} Tobacco for
5 days attendance and riding 3 times 14 miles and returning as a witness for him at
the suit of John Scott and Thom^b Scott.

Ordered that Lewis Martin pay to Littlebury Mason 200^{ft} Tobacco for 5 days attendance and
riding 25 miles and returning as witness for her at the suit of John Barnes.

Ordered that James Gray pay to Lewis Gray 200^{ft} for 8 days attendance
as a witness for him against Jeremiah Tyler.
