Ordained that Abraham Mitchell Matthew Wells and William Edwards or any two of them let to the lowest bidder the repairs of the bridge over Kottoway swamp below Jones Mills and report

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Josiah Vick of the one part and William Murfee of the other part with the memorandum and receipt thereon under seal was taken agreed by the said Vick and ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Tom a manumitted Negro who offered sufficient reasons to the court he is excused from payment of taxes levied &c

On the motion of Haray Dayell who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Pinchon Dayel deceased giving Security whereupon the said Haray Dayel with Law Dayel his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one hundred pounds for the said Haray Dayell due and faithful administration on the estate of the said deceased

Ordered that Jacob Bradshaw Charles Powers Sampson Pitman and John Drury or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this county do appraise in current money the Slaves (if any) and personal estate of Pinchon Dayel dead and return the appraisement to the next Court

On the petition of John Rochelle for leave to erect a water grist mill over Dick's Swamp and setting forth that he hath lands on one side thereof opposite to the lower end of section of Jany Drake and praying for an act of the said land for the abatement of his dam it is ordered the Sheriff summon a jury of free free holders the said jury to meet upon the said land and being first sworn before a justice of the peace or the said Sheriff do diligently view and examine the use of land petitioned for and the lands adjacent thereto on both sides of the said Swamp that may be over flowed or otherwise damaged by building the said mill together with the timber and other conveniences thereon and that they report the same together with the true value of the same petitioned for and the damages to the party holding the same or to any other person or persons to the next Court under their hands and seals

The persons appointed to let the repairs of a flat boat at black water at the old cane house and furnishing materials this day made their report in hereupon it is ordered that the treasurer of this county pay to James Andrews this County's proportion of seven pounds nine pence shillings for repairing the said flat sending a rope and taping the plug for the term of six months

Henry Jones is appointed by the Court Surveyor of the said from Approp Swamp to Black Oak Ridge and it is ordered that he with the free laboring inhabitants of his precinct keep the same in repair
