appearing or offering any thing in their defense therefore on the motion of the  
Attorney for the Commonwealth it is considered that the said defendants  
make their fine with the Commonwealth by the payment of five  
hundred pounds of tobacco each according to the act of assembly in that  
case made and provided that they also pay the costs of this prosecution
