Ordered that Barker pay to Wm Barker 100 ^{lb} Tobacco for 2 days attendance on this court & riding 12 miles twice as a witness for him at the suit of Newson

Ordered that James Gray pay to Newson Branch 80 ^{lb} Tobacco for 2 days attendance as a witness for him against Jeremiah Tyler

Ordered that James Gray pay to John Reed 80 ^{lb} Tobacco for seven days attendance on this court as a witness against Jeremiah Tyler

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court in course
