The last will and testament of Thomas Britton deceased was presented in court by Thomas Britton & Robert Rickes the executors therin named & proved by the <sup>25</sup> solemn affirmation of Jenny Britton & Mary Schell the subscribing witnesses thereto as also by the affirmation of Samuel Bailey who deposed that the said will was in the hand writing of the said Thomas Britton the testator which is ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executors who affirmed according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form of giving Security whereupon the said Thomas Britton & Robert Rickes with William Bailey John T Blaw their securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand pounds for their due and faithful administration <sup>decs</sup> of the estate of the said deceased & performance of his will

Ordered that Bennill Williamson William Bailey James Lancaster & Harman Harris or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves & personal estate of Thomas Britton deceased and return the appraisement to the next court
