An Indenture of bargain & sale between Samuell Atkinson Sarah Atkinson and Isham Atkinson of the one part & Jacob Newsum of the other part was ack^d & acknowledged by Isham Atkinson having been before acknowledged by the other parties & the s^d Sarah examined as the law directs is ordered to be recorded

The court recommends to the Governor Micajah Holliman Geo. Guley & John Simmons as fit and able persons to serve as sheriffs for this county the ensuing year

Ordered that the treasurer pay M^{rs} Nick four pounds fifteen shillings for clearing the logs from the Three Cypress bridge & taking care of the same

Frances Mountfort orphan of Thomas Mountfort died came into court and chose Henry Jones for her guardian whereupon the said Henry Jones with Micajah Giffens his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two hundred pounds for the s^d Henry securing the s^d orphan's estate & indemnifying this court

Ordered that the treasurer pay to John Simmons jr. seven pounds for clearing logs from Cays bridge & taking care of the s^d bridge for 2 years

Ordered that Micajah Holliman James Lancaster & Wm Vezemhart or any two of them in conjunction with persons to be appointed by the worshipful court of Isle of Wight lett the repairs necessary to be made to Proctors bridge & make report thereof to this court

An account current of the estate of Wm Williams died was reported by the persons appointed to settle the same & ordered to be recorded

John Edwards wth an amount of taxes collected by him as deputy under John Rogers which was sworn to accord to law & ordered to be certified
