An account current of the estate of Sarah Nicholson was reported & ordered
to be recorded

An indenture of bargain and sale between Thomas Clements
of the one part and Richard Parker Clements of the other part with
the receipt thereon endorsed were acknowledged by Thomas Clements
and record to be recorded.

An indenture of bargain and sale between Lewis Journe & Lucy
his wife and John Gardner with the receipt thereon endorsed were acknow-
ledged by the Lewis Journe and Lucy his wife the being first privately
examined as the documents and ordered to be recorded

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of Robert Carr deceased was re-
turned and ordered to be recorded

For sufficient reasons appearing to the court ^{a negro slave} Prunick belonging to William
Ridley is exempted from the payment of taxes

Ordered that the overseer of poor for the said district Notley parish bind
out Elizabeth Scott

Elisha Darden is by the court appointed guardian to Thomas Edmunds orphan of late
Edward Whetstone the said Darden with Samuel Kello his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two hundred pounds for the safe keeping the said orphans
estate & contents of the court

Absent George Gurley present Micajah Holman
An indenture of bargain and sale between Daniel Story and Elizabeth his wife of the
one part and Stephen Hanesake of the other part was proved by the oaths of George
Gurley & Jos Vicks two of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved by
the oath of another witness with the commission for the privy examination
of Elizabeth Story & certificate of the execution thereof ordered to be recorded

The last will and testament of Robert Bowdon deceased was presented in court by
Thomas Bowdon one of the executors John Burset the other executor refusing to
take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof proved by the oaths of Elias
Bowdon and John Powell two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

And on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate
is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon
the said Thomas Bowdon with Moses Johnson his security entered into and
acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the
said Bowdon true and faithful administration on the estate of the
said decedent & performance of his will
