An inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Pope was returned and ordered to be recorded

The last will and testament of Thomas Williamson presented in court by John Taylor and William Arguehart the executors therein named proved by the oaths of John Andrews, Henry Arguehart & Samuel Hells witness thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said John Taylor and William Arguehart with William Edmunds their security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of thirty three - sand pounds for the said John Taylor & William Argueharts due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that John Andrews John Dayton Timothy Atkinson & Benjamin Cook or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves and personal estate of Thos: Williamson deceased and return the appraisement to the next court

An inventory and appraisement of the estate of John Mountfort deceased was returned and ordered to be recorded

An indenture of bargain and sale between Hartwell Newsom of the one part and Wm. Newsom of the other part was proved by the oaths of Charles Holt Charles Newsom & Rinchen Felker two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Lewis Joiner who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining letter of administration on the estate of the estate of Lewis Joiner and giving security whereupon the said Lewis Joiner with William Whitehead & Arthur Doler his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand pounds for the said Lewis Joiner due & faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that John Davis Thomas Timmons Ro B Price & Joseph Walker any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves and personal estate of Lewis Joiner deceased and return the appraisement to the next court

On the motion of Cordall Mifflin and for sufficient reasons appearing to the court his Negroe woman Nott is exempted from the payment taxes
