At a Court of Oyer and Terminer held at the Courthouse on Monday the 23rd
day of July 1787 for the trial of Ben a negro man slave belonging to Miles
Carey for feloniously breaking and entering the Smoke-house of Thomas Kipburgh
of this County on the night of the 16th of June last and taking thenceout sundry pieces
of Bacon of the Value of Twenty three shillings

The Court being thus constituted the prisoner was led to the bar and charged with
the felony afores^t to which he plead not Guilty And divers witnesses being examined
and the prisoner heard in his own defence On Consideration whereof and of the
circumstances of the case it is the opinion of the Court that the prisoner is guilty of
the felony afores^t Therefore it is Considered by the Court that for the felony afores^t
he be hung by the neck till he be dead. And it is ordered that the sheriff of
this County cause execution of this sentence to be done & performed at the usual place
on Wednesday the 22nd day of August next sometime between the hours of twelve & two in
the afternoon
