sum of five pounds sixteen eight pence And Ann Briggs to pay
Charles Briggs the sum of sixteen shillings eight pence - Given under
our hands this 13th day of June 1787. Wm Thomas Mallett John
Rockelle Whereupon it is decreed and ordered that the report aforesd be
made the decree of this court be firm stable and binding between the
parties that the costs be equally borne by the parties
