

It a court continued and held for the county of Southampton the 11<sup>th</sup> day of August 1787.

On the motion of Joseph Gurley a witness for John A Rogers at the suit of John Banow it ordered that the said Rogers pay to him one hundred and fifty pounds of Tobacco for six days attendance on this court according to law

Ordered that John A Rogers pay to Matthew Gurley 12 s<sup>6</sup> to 10 s<sup>6</sup> for 4 days attendance on this court as a witness for him at the suit of John Banow

Ordered that John A Rogers pay to Jesse Braswell 3 s<sup>6</sup> to 10 s<sup>6</sup> for 2 days attendance <sup>riding</sup> and 30 miles twice and returning according to law as a witness for him at the suit of John Banow

William Whitehead a garnishee in this suit having deposed that he hath £147. 13. 6 in his hands due to the defendant This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the defendant not appearing. Therefore on the motion of the p<sup>ty</sup> it is considered by the court that he recover against the said defendant one pound nineteen shillings & three pence (which he proved to be due to him from the said de<sup>ft</sup> by his own oath) and also his costs in this behalf expended. And it is ordered that the s<sup>r</sup> William Whitehead pay to the s<sup>r</sup> p<sup>ty</sup> the amount of this judgment of 50<sup>n</sup> <sup>much remains in his hands</sup> after satisfaction of the judgments obtained against the s<sup>r</sup> de<sup>ft</sup> at a former day of this court

Ordered that John A Rogers pay to Thomas Turner a witness for him at the suit of Banow 4 s<sup>6</sup> to 10 s<sup>6</sup> for 16 days attendance on this court according to law

Therefore on the motion of the plaintiff it is considered by the court that he recover ag<sup>t</sup> 20 s<sup>6</sup> ag<sup>t</sup> the said defendant Eleven pounds the debt in the declaration mentioned this debt by him about his suit in this behalf expended the s<sup>r</sup> de<sup>ft</sup> in money &c. But this judgment except the costs is to be discharged by the payment of Five pounds twelve shillings with <sup>interest</sup> thereon from the 6<sup>th</sup> day of June 1786 all payment
