day returned and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Benjamin Harris & Elizabeth his wife  
of the one part and Thomas Edmunds of the other part with a receipt thereon  
endorsed were acknowledged by the said Benjamin Harris & Elizabeth his  
wife she being first privately examined at the law streets & ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Wm. Bennett who made oath according to law a certificate is  
granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Henry  
Blunt deceased giving security whereupon the S<sup>r</sup>. Bennett with Alldington  
from his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of  
One thousand pounds for the said Bennett due & faithful administration of  
the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that Wm. Cribblos Benjamin Edwards & Drury Cotton or any three of  
them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money  
the slaves if any personal estate of Henry Blunt deceased and return the ap-  
praisement to the next court

Martha Reddick orphan of James Reddick came into court before Wm. Hines  
for her guardian Whereupon the said Wm. Hines with Thos<sup>r</sup> Peete his  
fidelity entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one  
thousand pounds for the said Hines securing the estate of the S<sup>r</sup>. orphan and  
indemnifying the court

An Indenture of bargain & sale between Joseph Harrison & Elizabeth his wife  
of the one part and Benjamin Hale of the other part was acknowledged by the  
said Joseph Harrison & Elizabeth his wife she being first privately examined at the  
law streets and ordered to be recorded

An account current of the estate of Benwell Barnes deceased was this day re-  
ported by the person appointed to settle the same & ordered to be recorded

Mary Nicholson is by the Court appointed guardian to Fanny Matilda &  
Lucy Nicholson orphans of Joshua Nicholson deceased on his giving bond and  
security at the next Court

The last will and testament of William Blunt deceased was presented in court by Wm.  
Blunt the executor therein named and proved by the oaths of John Blunt & Lawrence  
Cooper two of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the said  
Peter who made oath according to law a certificate is granted him for obtaining  
a probate thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the S<sup>r</sup>. Wm. Blunt the execu-  
tor with Lelebury Mason and John Blunt entered into and acknowledged their bond in  
the penalty of fifteen thousand pounds for the S<sup>r</sup>. Executors due & faithful adminis-  
tration on the estate of the decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that Henry Smith James Turner Charles Robt & Henry Ramsay or any  
three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do apprise in  
current money the slaves and personal estate of Wm. Blunt deceased out of  
the appraisement to the next Court
