B. Wommack his security entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of four hundred pounds for the s^d Janett's due & faithful administration on the estate of the decedent & performance of his will

Ordered that Henry Harris on James Leedy Benjamin Harris on & Rich^d Harris on or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Foster Morgan died & return the appraisement to this Court

An Indenture of bargain & sale between John Holliday of Nanaimo of the one part and Tho^s Ridley of Southampton of the other ^{with a receipt thereon} part was acknowledged by the s^d Holliday & ordered to be recorded

Ordered that Tho^s Ridley Nicholas Magat & Samuel Edmunds or any two of them examine state and settle an account current of Edm^d Day's estate & make report thereof to this Court

31 The last will and testament of Kinross Jackson died was presented in Court by John Jackson and Newel Edwards the executors therein named & proved by the oaths of Patience Jackson and John Joynes two of the witnesses thereto & ordered to be recorded And on the motion of the s^d executors who made oath according to law a probat thereof is granted them on giving bond & security Whereupon the s^d executors with Tho^s Fitzhugh & Jonas Bryant their securities entered into & acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Three hundred pounds condition for the true & faithful administration on the estate of the decedent & performance of his will by the s^d Executors

Ordered that Micajah Edwards Charles Birdsong Barton Taylor & John Delt or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in current money the slaves & any personal estate of Kinross Jackson died & return the appraisement to the next Court

An Indenture of bargain & sale between Can Dayel & Charity his wife of the one part & John Garstapen of the other part with a receipt thereon ordered were acknowledged by the said Can Dayel & Charity his wife & being first examined as the law directs & ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the owners of the poor bind out James & Randolph Turner poor children of Peg Turner the first named, to Wm. Bennett & the other to Nathl Rochelle according to the

The last will & testament of John Underwood was presented in Court by Tho^s Edmunds & Thomas Vaughan executors therein named & proved by the oaths of Robert Carr
