Ally Beale appeared on a recognizance entered into by him for beguiling a bastard child on the body of Mary Jones whereupon the s<sup>d</sup> Ally Beale with James Wright & Asa Beale his securities ~~all entered~~ themselves indebted to the Governor of this Commonwealth this recognizance that is to say the said Ally Beale in £35.0.0 & his securities in £15.0.0 each of them respective lands and lineaments goods and chattels leased & to the s<sup>d</sup> Governor or his executors & assigns yet upon this condition that the s<sup>d</sup> Ally Beale shall pay or cause to be paid such sum or sums of money as the overseers of the poor for this county shall annually demand for the sole purpose of maintaining the s<sup>d</sup> bastard child until it arrives to a proper age to be bound out then this obligation to be void

Joseph Benthall returned his account of his guardianship of the estate of the estate of Joseph Turner orphan of Sampson Turner which was examined by the court sworn to by the guardian & ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the court in course
