execution thereof giving Security whereupon the Said Howell
Edmunds with John Rogers his Security entered into and acknow-
ledged their bond in the penalty of fifty pounds for the sd Howell
Edmunds, due and faithful Administration for the estate of
the decedent

Ordered that Jacob Turner be summoned to appear at ^{the next Court} to answer
if any he can why he has not returned an account current of the
estate of John Sumner deceased

Ordered that Thomas Lane Arthur Eum and Charles Willan
or any two of them view the repairs of Round Hill bridge and report

Ordered that the Treasurer pay to Sampson Petman one pound
five shillings for repairs done to round Hill bridge
