Abigail Jones is recommended by the court to his excellency the Governor of this commonwealth as Colonel of the regiment of militia of this county on the North Side of Nottoway river

Samuel Vello is by the court recommended to his excellency the Governor of this commonwealth as lieutenant Colonel of the regiment of militia of this county on the north side of Nottoway river

John Simmons s^r is by the court recommended to the Governor as Lieutenant Colonel of the Regiment on the south side of Nottoway

William is by the court recommended as Major of the regiment on the south side of Nottoway and Elias Herring major of the regiment on the north side

The court recommend to the governor ^{son} John Wilkin as captain of a comp^y of the militia of the regiment on the south side of Nottoway in the room of William Cammends William Blunt a lieutenant & Henry Blunt an ensign

Edmund Tyler is by the court recommended as captain in the regiment on the north side of the river - John Simmons jr. lieutenant & Robert Goodwyn ensign

James Wilkinson is by the court recommended as Capt. of the light Company of infantry on the No side of the river & Hartwell Cooke as Captain of the light Company on the South side.
