A deed under the hand seal of Thomas Joiner for the emancipation of his negro Sam was acknowledged by him & ordered to be recorded

A deed in trust from Phelous Taylor to Wm Ridley was acknowledged by the 3 Taylor and ordered to be recorded

Josiah Vick came into court and took the oath prescribed by law as a captain of the militia of this county

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the Court in course
