Ordered that Henry Thorne Jesse Cooper Lewis Harris and William Harris or any three being first sworn before a justice of the peace do appraise in Current money the Slaves if any and personal estate of James Pond decd and return the appraisement to the next Court

Jesse Carr is by the Court appointed a Constable and ordered that that the Sheriff summon him to attend at the next Court to qualify according to law

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court in Course
