Pursuant to an act of Assembly directing the mode of proceeding under certain executions It is ordered that Mark Nicholson Thomas Holleday, Arthur Applewhite Benjamin Williams and Jacob Turner on the South Side of Nottoway River and Edmund Tyler William Edwards Jacob Turner and John Simmons Son of Charles on the North Side of Nottoway be appointed commissioners for valuing property taken by execution as directed the act aforesaid

Ordered that the overseers of the poor in the upper District of Stokes parish bind out James Blow orphan of Richard Blow according to law

On the motion of Thomas Vaughan and for sufficient reasons appearing to the Court his negro Thomas is exempted from the payment of taxes county and poor rate levies for the year 1796 and during his disability

In the motion of John Tho Blow his negroes Sim and Sapiro be exempted from the payment of taxes county and poor rate levies during their disability

An Indenture of bargain and Sale between
his wife of the one part and Holmes of the other part with
the receipt thereon enclosed was acknowledged by Laines and continued
for wife

Ordered that James Butts John Johnson Henry Pope and John Pladger (on the motion of Robert Speed) being first sworn before a justice of the peace of this County impartially to perform the service review the conveniences and inconveniences of turning a road on the S Robt Speeds lands and make report to this Court

In the motion of Robert Speed his negro Anthony is exempted from the payment of taxes for the year 1797 and in future

Ordered that the treasurer pay to Matthew sent two pounds for helping logs from Canys Bridge

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court in Cause
