Tom, Isaac, Jeff, Milley, Winney, John, Peter, & Peter, & Peter, Joseph Turner and Rhoda his wife Elizabeth Hines and Patsy Hines, their different attorneys are as follows Joseph Turner and Rhoda his wife on paying to Patsy Hines eleven pounds each to receive, Dick, Young, Seekey, Tom and Doll. Elizabeth Hines on paying to Patsy H. Hines fourteen pounds each to receive, Kate, George, Amey, Winney and Peter. Patsy H. Hines to receive Sam, Sam, Winney, John, & Milley, also the balance of six pounds above mentioned, as appears to us to be equal. Given under our hands at Haverhill the 1st day of January 1788.
