An Indenture of bargain and sale between *Reuben Vick* and *Rebecca* his wife of the one part and *Pilgrim Vick* of the other parts was proved by the oaths of *William Reeves* *William Newsum* and *Thos. Jackson* the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

The last will and testament of *Mary Sutton* dec^d was presented into Court by *Mary Smith* one of the executors therein named proved by the oaths of *James Vaughan* *Phabe Vaughan* and *Ans. Halcourt* the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded; was on the motion of the said *Mary Smith* whom as a oath according to law entitles is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security. Whereupon the said *Mary Smith* with *William Blunt* and *Lazarus* took his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three thousand pounds for the said *Mary* and *administrators* on the estate of the said dec^d for performance of his will.

Ordered that *Thos. Blunt* *James Turner* *Thos. Edwards* and *Lazarus* for or any three of them appraise in current money the share of any of the estate of *Mary Sutton* dec^d and return the appraisement to this Court.
