This day came the parties by their attorneys and thereupon came also a jury to wit. John Keady Sterling (Justice) Josiah Morrill William Bailey William Searles Henry Adams Henry Morris Saml. Calvert Mr. Justice William Angwin Robt. Adams & Nathl. Rockwell who being elected true and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oath as say that the defendants have not paid the debt in the declaration mentioned in manner herein against her the plaintiff hath complained. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant one hundred and seventy pounds six shillings and eight pence the debt in the declaration mentioned and her costs by him on their behalf repaid to be curia of the goods and chattels of the said James Taylor at the time of his death in the hands of Eliz. Smith to be ascertained if so much he hath if not the costs to be made of the property and chattels of the said defendant & he in Moneys. And this judgment is to be discharged by the payment of Eighty five pounds three shillings and four pence and that thereon to be computed after the rate of 5 p. c. p. annum from the 19th day of June 1775 till payment
