On the motion of Joseph Scott who made oath according to Law for administration on the estate of Jacob Bep. &c. the same is granted him on his giving bond and security. Whereupon the said Joseph Scott with Josiah Weeks his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the said Joseph due & faithful administration on the estate of the said deceased.

Ordered that Bury, Beal, Josiah Beal, Shadrach Lewis and John Bryant or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County as appraisers in Current money the slaves, free and personal estate of Jacob Bep. &c. & return the apprais. to the Court.
