

A Deed in trust between Dr. Porter of the one part and Nathan Barnes of the other part was proved by the oath of John Barnes one of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Nathan Barnes he is exempted from the payment of taxes he is due in future.

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court to let the rebuilding of Fort's bridge over the 3 crabs to Joseph Fort's filed a return within report as follows to wit: In Obviance to an order of this Court the subscribers have let the rebuilding of Fort's bridge over the three crabs to Joseph Fort for the sum of Fifty pounds. Given under our hands this 10th of September 1788. Dr. Simmons Benj Lewis and it is ordered that Dr. Simmons Benj Lewis and Thomas Williams or any two of them view the said bridge and make report whether the same is completed according to agreement.

Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Eliz^a Daughtry dec^d was this day returned and ordered to be recorded.

Nathan Marks is by the Court appointed surveyor of the road in the town of Fort Maud and it is ordered that the said Nathan with the male labouring men belonging to the said road keep the same in repair according to Law.

John Carr Stephan is by the Court appointed surveyor of the highway in the town of Dr. Morris and it is ordered that he keep the same in repair according to Law.

The last will and testament of Mary Westbrook dec^d was presented in Court by Arthur Foster the executor therein named proved by the oaths of William Claus and John Claus 2 witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of the said executor who made a solemn affidavit as required by the law is granted him for obtaining a separate shroff in due form giving security. Whereupon the said Arthur Foster with Dr. Wendell his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said Arthur Foster and faithful administration in the estate of the said dec^d and performance of her will.

Ordered that John Barnes Samuel Francis William Claus and Dr. Gray or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for the County appear in Court monthly the slaves of any real personal estate of Mary Westbrook dec^d and return the appraisement to the Court.
