The last will and testament of Pitt Williamson dec^d was presented in Court by Sarah Williamson the executrix therein named proved by the oaths of Jno Crumpler Benjamin Crumpler and John Crumpler witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executrix whomade according to law certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security Whereupon the said Sarah Williamson with Jno Crumpler her security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of Five hundred pounds for the said Sarah's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of her will

Ordered that Jno Britt, Jacob Turner Thomas Britt and Benoit Crumpler or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County do appraise in Current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Pitt Williamson dec^d and return the appraisement to this Court

On the motion of Thomas King whomade oath according to Law for administration on the estate of Henry Jagers dec^d the same is granted him on giving bond and security Whereupon the said Thomas King with William Magistart his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the said Thos King's due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that Thosarch Lewis Bay, Beale Jno Powers & Joshua Dielor any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County do appraise in Current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Henry Jagers dec^d and return the appraisement to this Court
