As a account Current of the estate of James Scott dec'd was this reported by the persons appointed to settle the said estate and ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Jacob Fauson for judgment against John Rogers Sheriff of this County for £310 and 2/3 of a pound & interest & also as the amount of tickets put into his hands for collection for the years 1786 & 1787. it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the defendant had the legal notice of this motion it is considered by the Court that the said Fauson have judgment against the said Sheriff for the amount of the said tickets & his costs by him on this behalf required &c
