Doctor Joseph Holmes a surgeon reporting that William Simmons who was a soldier in the war under Col. Buford and who hath made application for a recommendation to be placed on the pension list is so disabled by a wound in his arm as to render him incapable of having the proper use of it, and that he hath also several other wounds of less consequence and the Court from their personal knowledge of the said William Simmons being satisfied he is and probably ever will be incapable of manual labor by means of the said wound, and being also sufficiently convinced that he received these wounds in the service of Col. Buford recommend him as a proper person to be placed on the pension list and receive the bounty of his County

It appearing to the Court that the bridge over Nottingham at this place is in danger of falling for want of some repairs, therefore it is ordered that Josiah Nick, William Mitchell, Thomas Edmunds and John Kochell or any two of them examine the said bridge and let the necessary repairs be made report thereof to this Court

Ordered that the owner of the field road from Capt Barnes eastward to the old Nottingham line open and extend the said road to the County line with the land belonging to his district, and it is ordered that he keep the said road in repair according to law
