It appearing to the Court that the former order of the Court appointing trustees to Laurence Segner was illegal, therefore it is ordered that he be released from the sum.

An account Current of the estate of Robert Mercer dec^d was this day reported by the persons appointed to settle the same and ordered to be read.

The persons appointed by a former order of this Court to view the conveniences and inconveniences of turning a road near Joseph Dexters this day made their report in the following words to wit: In obedience to an order of the worshipful Court of Southampton bearing date September 1788, we have viewed the ground for turning a road near Joseph Dexters and find it will be an advantage to the public more to any private individual the ground for the new road being one hundred yards shorter than the old one and when opened and put in good order will be as easy kept as the old road. Given under our hands this 11th day of December 1788. Shadrach Lewis, Joshua Beal, Bery Beal. Whereupon it is ordered that the said road be opened agreeable to the prayer of the petition.

Richard Worrell came into Court and chose Matthew Char^{les} as his guardian on his giving bond and security. Whereupon the said Matthew Char^{les} with Shadrach Worrell his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three hundred pounds for securing the said orphan estate and the indemnification of the Court.

John Castrophus is by the Court appointed guardian to Matthew Worrell orphan of Rich^d. Worrell on his giving security. Whereupon the said John Castrophus with John Worrell his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two hundred pounds for securing the said orphan estate and the indemnification of the Court.

Shadrach Worrell is by the Court appointed guardian to William Worrell orphan of Rich^d. Worrell giving security. Whereupon the said Shadrach Worrell with Matthew Char^{les} his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of three hundred pounds for securing the said orphan estate and the indemnification of the Court.
