An Indenture of bargain and sale between William Sumner and Bro Bailey of the one part and Charles Bailey of the other part was approved by the courts of Newsum Branch Martine Bailey and Peter Bailey witnesses thereof and ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Hannah Gray who made oath according to law for administration on the estate of John Gray dec^d the same is granted her on giving bond and security whereupon the said Hannah Gray with Mary Thomas her security entered into and acknowledged the above bond in the penalty of five hundred pounds for the said Hannah's use and faithful administration on the estate of the said dec^d

Ordered that Benjamin Blount Samuel Francis James Leung and Drury Harris or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County appraise in current money the shares of any and personal estate of Bro Gray dec^d and return the appraisment to this Court.
