

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Richard Johnson and Lucy his wife of the one part and William Mansuph of the other part was proved by the oaths of Thomas Ridley Mansuph Newsum and Moses Foster three of the witnesses chosen and with the commissioners for the p[ri]v[ate] examination of Mrs Johnson and certificate of its execution returned is ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between James Sumner wife of the one part and Arthur Dole of the other part was acknowledged by James Sumner wife the party chosen and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Virginia Vick of the one part and Brittain, Fleming of the other part was proved by the oath of Jonas Briggitt and having been before proved by the oaths of Sarah Wrenn and Gordon Vick is ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Jeyner and his wife of the one part and Vick of the other part was acknowledged by Jeyner and Jantines for wife

On the motion of Charles Briggs who made oath according to law for administration on the estate of Richard Mines &c. the same is granted him on his giving bond and security, whereupon the said Charles Briggs with Richard Parker his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one hundred pounds for the said Charles Briggs and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that Braggins Stewart Michael Ellis John Kelly and Jeph Arrington or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for their county appraise in current money the slaves if any and personal estate of Richard Mines &c. and return the appraisement to this court

The last will and testament of Drury Parker &c. was presented in Court by Mansuph Newsum the executor therein named, Rich^d Parker the other refusing and the said will having been proved to the satisfaction of the Court to be wholly in the hand writing of the testator is ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security, whereupon the said Mansuph Newsum with William Myrick his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of five thousand pounds for the said Mansuph's due
