The last will and testament of Samuel Cobb dec^d, was produced in Court by Matthew and Kinchen Cobb executors therein named proved by the oaths of Dempsey Cooper and Thomas Pope two of the witnesses therein and ordered to be recorded, And on the motion of the said executors whomask oath according to law, certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security, whereupon the said Matthew & Kinchen Cobb with Thomas Pope their security entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of one hundred pounds for the due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent and performance of his will

Ordered that Abraham Mitchell Matthew Mills Thomas Lawrence and William Nelson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace for this County appraise in current money the slaves of any and persons estate of Sam^l Cobb & return the appraisment to the Court

An In a nature of bargain and sale between Matthew Britt and Catherine his wife of the one part and Thomas Stephenson of the other part was proved by the oaths of Edmund Tyler and Elias Herring two of the witnesses therein and having been proved by the oath of William Boghins and with the commission for the proving examination of Mrs Britt and Certificate of its execution return is in order to be recorded

On the motion of Robert Wilkins his negroes Yancy & Jimmy are exempted from the payment of taxes here be in future

Milley Parker is by the Court appointed guardian to Nancy Thomas Susan, Temperance, Judith, Polly, Betsey, and Matthew Parker orphans of Doremy Parker dec^d on her giving bond and security, whereupon the said Milley Parker with Nathaniel Stanton and William Stanton her securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of two thousand pounds procuring the said orphans entered and the indemnification of the Court
