of Dempsey Cooper and Thomas Pope two of the witnesses thereto and ordered
to be recorded, and on the motion of the said executors who made oath
according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate
thereof in due form giving security whereupon the said Matthew &
Richard Cobb with Thomas Pope their security entered into and acknowledged
a good stand bond in the penalty of one hundred pounds for the full
and faithful administration on the estate of the said incident and
performance of his will

Ordered that Abraham Mitchell Matthew Wells Thomas Lawrence
and William Kilian or any three of them being first sworn before a justice
of the peace for this County appear in Court to swear the slaves of
any and personal estate of Sam^r Cobb & return the appraiser to the Court

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Matthew Britt and his father in
his wife of the one part and Thomas Steptoe of the other part was
proved by the oaths of Edmund Tyler and Elias Herring two of the witnesses
thereto and having been before proved by the oath of William Bogkins and
with the commission for the full examination of Mrs Britt and
certificate of its execution return is ordered to be recorded

On the motion of Robert Wetherspoon George Gurney & Jenny are
exempted from the payment of taxes here to be in future

Milly Parker is by the Court appointed guardian to Nancy Thomas,
Susan, Temperance, Sarah, Polly, Betty, and Matthew Parker
orphans of Drury Parker esq^r on her giving bond and security
whereupon the said Milly Parker with Nathaniel Stanton and
William Stanton her Sureties entered into and acknowledged their bond
in the penalty of two thousand pounds for securing the said orphans estates
as the indemnification of the Court
