

The last will and testament of David Hines dec^d was proved by the oaths of Richard Hallam and John Arrington two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the motion of John Simmons who made oath according to law administration with the will annexed is granted him on the said estate giving security when upon the said John Simmons with Thomas Arundel his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of fifty pounds for the due and faithful administration on the estate of the said decedent

Ordered that John Simmons Jeph^r Arrington Michael Elies and John Hardy or any three of them being first sworn upon a justice of the peace for this County appraise in Current Money the Slaves if any and personal estate of David Hines dec^d and return the appraisment to the Court

Ordered that the Sheriff pay Mary Windham ten pounds for her pension for the present year she producing her certificate and making oath that her circumstances are not altered

Ordered that the Sheriff pay Anne Hargrave six pounds for her pension for the present year she producing her certificate and making oath that no change has happened in her circumstances

On the motion of Joel Davis who made it appear to the satisfaction of the Court that he had one free, titheable so much lent to him, therefore it is ordered that the tax on the same be remitted

Ordered that Bry^r Deane William Hines and Thomas Edmunds or any two of them examine the estate and settle an account current of Thomas Deane or of Bry^r Clements dec^d who was guardian to Thomas Clements Children and make report thereof to this Court

The last will and testament of William Boykin dec^d was proved in Court by William Boykin the executor therein named proved by the oaths of Edward M^r and Stephen Summerville two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of the said executor who made oath according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof in due form giving security when upon the said William Boykin with Michael Williamson his security entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of one thousand pounds for the due & faithful administration on the E^t of the said decedent & payment of his will
