

Ordered that ~~the~~ ^{the} ~~other~~ ^{other} Dales James Summers and Brother Baykin and Thomas Summers or any three of them being first sworn before any justice of the peace for this County appraise in current money the slaves of any and personal estate of William Baykin ~~de.~~ and return the appraisal to this Court.

William Summers producing a certificate from the execution of his being entitled to a pension of fifteen pounds per annum and his name appearing on the list of pensioners as entitled to the said sum, therefore it is ordered that the Sheriff pay him the said forty five pounds for his pension for three years the same commencing from the first day of June 1786

Ordered that the Treasurer of this County pay Simon Baykin this County proportion of Eight pounds, nineteen shillings for keeping a flat at the Old Court house six months and finding a rope for the same &c

Benjamin Beal's manumission for his negro man Mingo was acknowledged by the said Benj. Beal and ordered to be recorded

James Scotts manumission of Ben Sam. Cherry, Pompey, was acknowledged by the said James Scott and ordered to be recorded

A writing under the hand and seal of Meriam Scott for the manumissions of Robin Cornwall, Venus, Felix, and Rachelle was acknowledged by the said Meriam Scott and ordered to be recorded

Robert Stephenson orphan of Thomas Stephenson came into Court and chose Mary Stephenson for his guardian, whereupon the said Mary Stephenson with her security entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of _____ pounds, for securing the said orphans estate and the insinuation of the Court

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Nicolas Cobb of the one part and Shadrach Cobb of the other part was proved by the oaths of Jordan Denson Benjamin Beal and Joshua Beal three of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded

Squire Johnson orphan of John Johnson ~~de.~~ chose David Worrell his guardian on his giving security, whereupon the said David Worrell with Elijah Worrell his security entered into and acknowledged their bonds in the penalty of three hundred pounds for securing the said orphans estate and the insinuation of the Court
