estate and the indemnification of the Court

A writing under the hands and seal of Benjamin Whitfield for the manumission
of sundry slaves therein named was acknowledged by the said Ben. Whitfield
and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that John F. Blow, John Wright, and Thomas Holladay or any two
of them view the ground between the two taverns at this place and pick upon
some convenient spot for a drain for the waters that may be collected between
the said houses

Ordered that Thomas Pitt, Arthur Applewhite and Henry Thorp or any two
of them take the rebuilding of Moore's bridge across the three creeks and make
report thereof to this Court

Ordered that the treasurer of this county pay to Josiah Wick administrator
of Matthew Vick dec? twenty three shillings and four pence for services done
by the said decedent in keeping logs from the three Cypress bridge for seven
+ months

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till Court in Course
