 accordingly hereby dissolved. and that the Complainant pay unto the
 defendant in this direction eighty pounds, with Int. thereon to be computed
 after the rate of 5^l. 00 p. 100 annum from the 1st day of January 1783
 till paid, also the further sum of eighty pounds, with Int. from the 1st
 day of January 1784 till paid, and also the further sum of eighty
 pounds and Int. from the 1st day of January 1785 to the time
 of payment and the Costs of the suit at Common Law, from which
 judgment the defendant prays an appeal to the High Court of Chancery
 in Richmond, the same is granted him on giving bond and security
 at the next Court —
