Ordered that Josiah Nib Samuel Calvert William Evans and Joshua Port or any of them view the buildings on the public ground and report to the court what their opinion may appear to be nuisances and make report

An account current of the estate of Saint Simon was this day reported and ordered to be recorded

An Indenture of bargain and sale from William Blaw to Henry Blaw was acknowledged by the said William Blaw and ordered to be recorded

A deed from Benjamin Whitfield for the emancipation of Benjamin Whitfield Jones and Lark was acknowledged by the S^t J^{ry} and ordered to be recorded

this court by the plaintiff and the deft

This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing by affidavit of that the deft had had legal notice of this the plaintiff as solemnly called but came not therefore it is considered by the plaintiff the p^lff may have execution of the deft for the p^lff's debt bond men^d and his costs by him expended But this must to be as charged by the p^lff and interest at 6% & from the

About James Jee p^{res} William Blaw

On the motion of Thomas Harrison for administration on the estate of Henry Harrison deceased (the widow refusing to qualify by a new under her hand and seal) who made oath according to law administration is granted him on the S^t estate on his giving bond and security whereupon said Thomas Harrison with James Jee James Person his securities entered into and acknowledged their bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars for the said Thomas and his faithful administration on the estate of the deceased and the indemnification of the court

Ordered that Wm Blunt Richard Harrison David Newsum and Solomon Dawson or any three of them being first sworn before a justice of the peace in this county do appear in convenient money the slaves if any personal estate of Henry Harrison deceased and make report on or before
