And say came the parties by their attorneys and the persons appointed by a summons of this court this day in a written report as follows. In obedience to a decree of the worshipful court of Southampton he is directed, we have respectively thereto made a division of the estate of Samuel Hart deceased—between Haray Doyal in right of his wife formerly Mary Hart widow of the said Samuel Hart and William Hart as guardian of Levis Hart, orphan of the said Samuel, as follows To Haray Doyal we have allotted one third of the lands whereof the said Samuel Hart did seize, including houses orchards &c. beginning on the top of a hill at the junction of a path leading from the house of the said Samuel Hart deceased to the road directing to Jerusalem, which road divides that part of the said land from Jacob Barnetts and running a direct line so as to strike the South West corner of a small soon field of David Washingtons adjoining the said land being the most Westly part of the said David Washingtons land under cultivation, with two Negroes Betty and Sam to the said Haray Doyal in right of his wife and the remaining part of the lands with the other slaves, Moses, Solomon, Lab, Maria and Dany to William Hart guardian of the said orphan, to which we have hitherto put our hands the 16th day of January 1802—Joshua Fort William Evans and David Washington—whereupon it is agreed and ordered that the report aforesaid be made the decree of this court and be firm stable and binding between the—
