On the motion of John Davis witness for Edward W. Tyler executor of Henry Adams against Robert Adams it is ordered that the said Edward W. Tyler pay him one dollar and six cents for two days attendance on this court according to law

On the motion of William Washington witness for Robert Adams against Edward W. Tyler executor of Henry Adams aforesaid it is ordered that the said Robert Adams pay him one dollar and six cents for two days attendance on this court according to law
