Abraham a negro man Slave the property of Micajah Griffin of this county of full age being charged says that on Saturday the night on which Simeon was killed he went home with Mr. Lander about $\frac{1}{2}$ hours in the night and that he went into the kitchen and saw Bob lying on the bed and that he spoke to him and that Bob the prisoner made him no answer and that he set some time and saw a Negro woman come in and he got up and saw Simeon lying
