Commencement on behalf of Maria Brown against Robert Rollings and Richard Adams the defendant appeared in discharge of their recognizance parties heard therefore is made that the said Robert Rollings and Richard Adams give security for their good behavior for the space of twelve months when upon the 2^d Robert Rollings and William Hart his security entered and acknowledged themselves bound to James Monroe Governor of this Commonwealth and to his Successors the said Robert Rollings in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Burrall Rollings and William Hart in the sum of Fifty Dollars each of their respective lands and tenements goods and chattles to be levied and for the use of the Commonwealth to be rendered upon this condition that the said Robert be of good behavior to all the Citizens of this Commonwealth and more especially to the said Maria Brown for the space of twelve Calendar months from this any then the above obligation be void or to be in full force and Richard Adams having failed to give security therefore it is made that he be committed to the custody of the Sheriff
