

John Blunt in his lifetime and the value of the same at the  
time of such advancement being made according to law that is  
to say those of the distributions to be allotted to their divisions of  
the lands generally who having been advanced therein shall  
bring the same into Hotch pot and those entitled to a part of  
who have been advanced therein to be entitled to their divisions  
of such property upon summing such as have been already ad-  
vanced into Hotch pot on the value of the same when advanced  
and that the Common formers aforesaid and settle and adjust  
and assign the said property as aforesaid, and it is further or-  
dained and decreed by consent of the parties that the advanced part  
be a true account for the property at its value when advanced  
and that it shall be considered as a valid receipt and  
the law Hotch pot and make report thereof to this court so  
order to a final decree
