The court being thus constituted the prisoner having been committed to the goal of this county was charged with the rape of a female and the said Polly Payley appeared behalf of the Commonwealth who was examined the court considering whereof into the circumstances of the case, that the prisoner ought not to be tried for the said offence therefore it is ordered that he be discharged.
